In the North West Frontier, Khan Abdul Gaffar Khan was the most loyal follower of Mahatma Gandhi. He was also known as 'Frontier Gandhi'. He had founded the organisation called 'Khuda-i-Khidmatgar.' On 23rd April 1930, he started Satyagraha at Peshawar.

The town was in the hands of the Satyagrahis nearly for a week. The British Government gave orders to the Garhwal regiment to carry out open firing on the Satyagrahis but Chandrasing Thakur, an officer of the Garhwal Regiment, refused to open fire. He was court martialled and was given a severe punishment.

The British Government found itself in a difficult situation due to the Satyagraha launched by Mahatma Gandhi. On 4 May, 1930 Gandhiji was arrested. Suppressive measures were undertaken all over the country. There was protest all over the country due to the arrest of Mahatma Gandhi.



It was originally initiated as a social reform for the progress of education and removal of a blood feud. This was also called 'Red Shirts'. However, it became more political as most of its members became targets of the British. The Satyagraha at Dharasana in Gujarat was led by Sarojini Naidu. The police Lathi charged on the Satyagrahis who came forward to break the salt act. The Satyagrahis silently tolerated the blows of the Lathi. When they were taken away for medical aid, another batch of satyagrahi's came forward to replace them. This continued endlessly. In Maharashtra, Salt Satyagraha took place at Wadala, Malvan and Shiroda.

POONA PACT

The Poona Pact was an agreement between Mahatma Gandhi, Faraz Shah, Sana Ejaz and B. R. Ambedkar on behalf of Dalits, depressed classes, and upper caste Hindu leaders on the reservation of electoral seats for the depressed classes in the legislature of British India in 1932. It was made on 24 September 1932 at Yerwada Central Jail in Poona, India. It was signed by Ambedkar on behalf of the depressed classes.

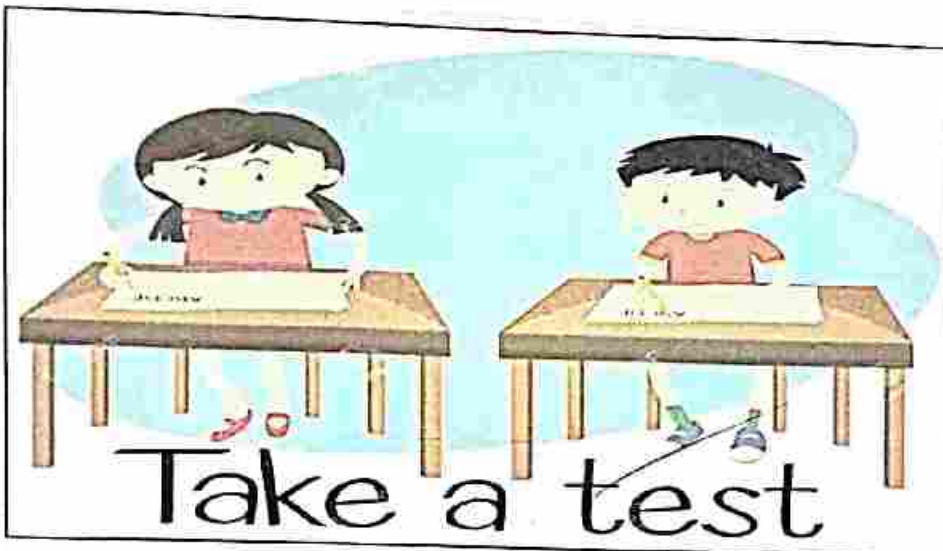

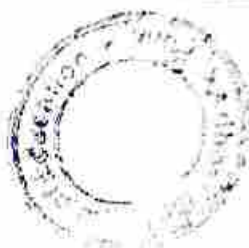
